



The Eastern Connecticut Conference Advisory Board has approved the following postseason experience for fall sports. Of course, under the circumstance's adjustments may be needed.

Football – The end of season event will be a combine for all senior and junior players. The event is on Saturday, October 31st at New London High School. No spectators.

Girls' Swimming/Diving – An in-person meet for all ECC teams (Top 15 swimmers from each team) will be held at East Lyme HS on November 7th. No spectators.

Field Hockey – All ECC teams will be divided into two groups. Top 4 schools will compete in a tournament (Semis, Finals and consolation game), lower three teams will play in a round robin competition with each team getting 2 games. All games will be at the higher ranked site. Spectator policy will be determined by the host school policy. Play dates are November 10th and 12th.

Boys' Soccer – The current ECC regions will be divided into 2 groups according to. Each group will have a competition with each team getting 2 games. All games will be at the higher ranked site. Spectator policy will be determined by the host school policy. Play dates are November 12th and 14th.

Girls' Soccer -

The current ECC regions will be divided into 2 groups according to seeding. Each group will have a competition with each team getting 2 games. All games will be at the higher ranked site. Spectator policy will be determined by the host school policy. Play dates are November 11th and 13th.

Volleyball - The current ECC regions will be divided into 2 groups according to seeding. Each group will have a competition with each team getting 2 games. All games will be at the higher ranked site. Spectator policy will be determined by the host school policy. Play dates are November 9th, 10th and 12th.

Cross Country – ECC will host three separate end of season meets. The meets will be held on November 4th at Harkness Memorial State Park in Waterford and at the South campus at Woodstock Academy. No spectators. Each team will be allowed 7 runners per boys'/girls' team.
